Behavioral Health Professional (BHP)

BHP training and certification is required for direct care providers working in Children's Behavioral Health Services, either in the school or home/community setting, in programs receiving MaineCare reimbursement for section 28 RCS, 28 RCS Specialized, and 65 HCT or Day Treatment Services. This is a hybrid course with 12 online modules equating to 37 hours, and an additional 8 hour day completed live and in-person. We will run two cohorts of this course, both beginning in June and ending in July. In-person portions will be in Harrington and Woodland. Woodland cohort will be 3 credit hours and the cost is \$388. Harrington cohort will be 3.7 CEU's and the cost is \$200. Call for more info and exact dates.
