What Is the TechHire Grant?

Available through the U.S. Department of Labor's Employment & Training Administration H1-B Grants Program, the TechHire Maine partnership will be used to help expand and enhance education and job training for Maine residents seeking to work in the information technology (IT) industry. The TechHire Maine program focus is to recruit, assess, train and place young adult and underserved individuals into Maine's IT industry.

Services Available Under TechHire

Each TechHire participant will receive intensive, wrap-around services to support individuals in obtaining well-paying, middle- and high-skilled occupations in Maine's Information Technology industry. Through the development of an individual service strategy, each participant will enter one of three service tracks:

<u>Track One</u> Rapid employment is reserved for candidates who require targeted career coaching or need to acquire an industry-specific credential to obtain employment. For those who have the interest, aptitude, or aspiration for IT but have not achieved technical competency.

<u>Track Two</u> will prepare the participant for employment utilizing accelerated or short-term training modalities leading to an industry recognized credential.

<u>Track Three</u> is designed for individuals with little work history or experience or who may be in need of the most intensive service intervention, including English language learners, individuals who are in need of work readiness skills, or those in need of developmental education programs.
