Paul Updike, MD was trained at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in New Hampshire. For the past fifteen years, he has directed Addiction Medicine Treatment Services for the Catholic Health System in Buffalo, New York, including the full continuum of substance use disorder services, from Methadone, to inpatient, to abstinence-based outpatient with more than a decade of experience with buprenorphine/medication assisted treatment. Dr. Updike excels as a mentor and trainer with vast down-to-earth and practical experience and advice.

X-Waiver Training/Prescribing Buprenorphine ~ 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Dr. Updike has obtained approval for individuals not yet waived to use this mentoring/face-to-face as the 50% portion not completed on-line. Health Center Medical Staff, even those already waived will be participating in specific prescribing dialogue and case discussion as a continuation of their long-term mentoring relationship with Dr. Updike. Conversations will be rich with examples and challenging prescribing issues.

Buprenorphine Treatment & Comorbidities ~ 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Dr. Updike's afternoon presentation will focus on three issues that complicate Medication Assisted Therapy (MAT). He will give the didactic information and lead a case review/discussion with Bucksport Regional Health Center Behavioral Health Supervisor, David Harlan, LCSW, sharing the cognitive portions of interventions. The three-hour time block will be broken into four separate themes: Substance Use Disorders ~ 1) Individuals with chronic pain, 2) Individuals with co-occurring mental health issues focusing on anxiety and depression, 3) Treatment during pregnancy, and 4) Other substance use disorders.
