WHY IS THIS CRITICAL?

Washington County has the highest rate of death due to drug overdose in the State of Maine. By creating a central coordinating telephone system that is staffed 24/7 the goal is to reduce the number of fatal overdoses.

WHO IS IT FOR?

Individuals can seek resource information for themselves or others. Anyone connected to those with substance use challenges is encouraged to reach out, including law enforcement, medical and emergency personnel, public officials, education staff, and other members of the public.

HOW DOES IT HELP?

The referral line connects callers with referral services to counseling, peer services, and recovery coaching. It is intended to bridge any gaps in services needed to support individuals in treatment and recovery.

The Washington County Information and Referral Line is a partnership between the State of Maine, the Washington County Substance Use Recovery Collaborative, and AMHC.
