PURPOSE

To provide comprehensive education and training in the care of patients who have suffered the trauma of sexual assault, in the collection of forensic evidence, and how to be a witness in court proceedings. This national training model utilizes an interdisciplinary, community-based approach for the dignified and compassionate care and treatment of adult, adolescent, and pediatric sexual assault patients.

March 23, 2024, is a clinical simulation day from 9a - 4p, and is only for healthcare providers. Healthcare providers must have a valid license to practice in Maine and have a minimum of one year of recent clinical practice in a hospital setting.
