AquEOUS is a USDA-NIFA funded, 10-week summer fellowship on the coast of Maine for 3rd and 4th year undergrads from any U.S. college or major. Fellows explore sustainable aquaculture, marine conservation, & community engagement through hands-on projects and mentorship. The program emphasizes Two-Eyed Seeing, bringing Indigenous knowledge systems and Western science together in service of resilient coastal communities.
